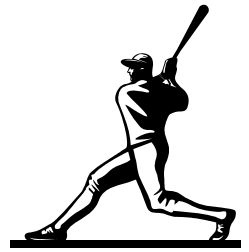

REGISTRATION INFORMATION



For your convenience there are two ways to complete the registration process:

IN PERSON: Registration dates are February 13 and 20 from 9:00 am—2:00 pm at the St. Joe Fire Station

Every player must provide three (3) proofs of residency and a copy of the state sealed birth certificate.

Coming in for registration gives you the opportunity to meet St. Joe Board members, provide the above information, have your player sized for their uniform, and get answers to any questions you may have.

ON LINE: On-line registration will be open after February 1, 2010. Visit the St. Joe Little League Website (www.stjoell.com) and follow the link for on-line registration. You will still need to provide the above listed proofs of residency and a copy of the state sealed birth certificate.

Note: Anyone signing up after April 1, 2010 (with the exception of Senior Softball and Big League Baseball) will incur a \$20 late fee.
